← The screen to the left shows an example of the main patient screen in AppMed. There are ten tabs in all that make up the entire patient folder.

The green section on the right side of the patient details screen summarizes much of the common information stored in the other sections of this patient folder. This provides an easy “at-a-glance” view for the user.

All of the editing functions needed to complete billing, scheduling, EMR, and patient relevant reporting can be done from this single location.

→ The screen to the right shows an example of a patient's insurance coverage.

AppMed maintains up to three consecutive insurance companies for each patient plus an “alternate primary” used to file for DME and Work Comp claims.

As old insurance coverages terminate, they turn red but are maintained for historical reference and used to re-file older claims.

An Insurance Website button exists which allows the user to instantly launch to the insurance website to verify eligibility or check claim status.
