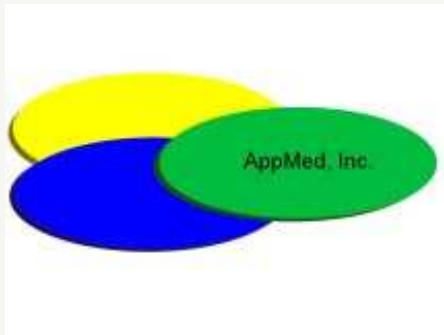

AppMed Releases Software Version 3.6



For our Summer 2008 version release, we have added a small, but useful, set of new features. We are sure you would rather be focusing on time with your family this summer instead of a long list of new AppMed features.

While we continue to ensure that our program is completely current with all electronic and paper insurance claim requirements, we have found a little extra time to add a new patient insurance screen to AppMed.

Beginning with design and through de-

velopment and testing, we are pleased with the outcome of this new screen.

It may take a little getting used to at first, but we are confident you will find it reduces the number of steps needed in this section of the program.

Another new feature is a check box in the Patient Even More Details screen that can be unchecked if you want to eliminate the patient from Patient Lists and Mailing Labels.

Speaking of Mailing Labels, we have added a Mailing Label option to the Patient Recalls list.

We are already hard at work on the Fall 2008 release and will keep you posted on our progress through our website www.appmed.com.

HOW TO UPDATE YOUR APPMED PROGRAM

- ◆ Download from our website www.appmed.com. Remember to go to the *Client Support* tab and enter your login number.
- ◆ If you do not have internet access, call us and we will mail a CD to your office.



Patient Insurance Screen

Once you update your AppMed program you can go to a patient and click on the Insurance tab. You will immediately see the change that was made.

If your program is located on one of our servers, we will update your program within a few days of your receiving this update notice.

Since the beginning of developing AppMed, we have wanted to do away with the list box that has occupied this screen.

We felt that the gray "stat" screen was redundant and should allow the user to edit the information without opening another window.

The new screen is much more like the rest of the patient file. You can use the tab key to navigate from field to field.

We moved the Insurance Company Website button from the upper icon bar to the new screen because we found that many users didn't even know we had this feature.

If the website is listed at the insurance company, clicking this button will open Internet Explorer and launch you directly to the company's web page.

We also added a button that allows the user to update the Insurance Subscriber's address information from the Patient Details screen to reduce the need to re-type information.

Include in Lists

Many of our clients use mailing lists extensively to market their practices. We strongly encourage this and have made this easier in version 3.6.

A new check box is located on the Patient Even More Details screen. The first time the new version is opened the Database Being Verified function takes a few extra seconds to check this

box for all of the patients.

You can then remove this check from any patient that you do not want included in any mailing list you generate from the Reports section of AppMed.

There is also a new list located in the Patient Lists section of Reports called "Patients Include in Lists Not Checked". You can print this report to view those patients whose box has been unchecked.

Ignored Statement Report

We have added a new report in the Monthly Statement Reports section called "Ignored Statement Report".

This report will print a list of patients that have been ignoring multiple statements.

It allows you to select the number of statements that have been sent and the report will return those patients whose balance has not changed.

This report can help you focus your collections more effectively.
